

# IGF 2024 MAG Meeting VI Action items & next steps

## 16 April 2024 | 11:00 UTC | Online

### 1. Updates from the Secretariat

- The Secretariat reminded the MAG to register on INDICO for the <u>Second Open Consultations and</u> MAG meeting.
- The Secretariat provided the current number of received village booths (17), remote hubs (14), workshops (2), Day-Zero events (1), Open Forums (1), Lightning Talks (2) and Dynamic Coalitions (1) proposals.
- The Secretariat will have a session at the WSIS High-Level forum on Tuesday, 28 May from 16:15 to 17:00 (CET), in addition to a booth.

#### **Actions**

→ The IGF Secretariat welcomes the inputs from the MAG Working Group on Strategy regarding the IGF session at the WSIS High-Level forum.

## 2. General Guidance for the Workshop Evaluation Process

- The co-facilitator of the MAG working group on workshop processes (WG-WSP) introduced the General Guidance for the IGF 2024 Workshop Evaluation Process.
- After the submission deadline of the IGF 2024 session proposals on 30 April:
  - The IGF Secretariat will conduct an initial screening of proposals from 1 to 10 May,
  - MAG members will evaluate individually sessions from their randomly assigned evaluation groups from 10 May to 9 June,
  - The MAG evaluation groups will agree on a recommended list of selected workshop proposals based on the "three baskets approach" from 14 to 23 June,
  - The MAG will approve the final list of selected workshops based on the evaluation groups' recommendations during the Second Open Consultations and MAG meeting from 26 to 28 June 2024.

#### 3. Approval of the IGF 2024 Workshop Evaluation Form

- The co-facilitator of the MAG WG-WSP presented the proposed <u>IGF 2024 workshop evaluation</u> criteria and weights, which follow very closely the scheme for 2023.
- The IGF 2024 workshop evaluation form showcases the evaluation scoring in greater detail.
- The IGF Secretariat provided a quick demo of the workshop evaluation process on the IGF website. MAG members were informed that a voluntary tutorial on how to evaluate workshop proposals will be organized for interested MAG members on 7 May.

- MAG members were informed about last month's <u>kick-off meeting</u> with over 60 participants, including the MAG Chair, several MAG members, and youth representatives from the IGF community.
- The co-facilitator of the MAG working group on youth engagement (WG-Youth) informed the MAG about the organization of a webinar, dedicated to IGF youth and focusing on providing guidance and support in the submission of IGF session proposals. MAG members, as well as the co-facilitators of the MAG working groups are welcomed to join and share their experiences. WG-Strategy

- The WG-Strategy will further discuss the (1) IGF Strategy (2) support the IGF Secretariat with the IGF session at the WSIS High-Level forum (3) discuss <u>comments received</u> in regard to the <u>GDC Zero Draft</u> and (4) NetMundial. Due to insufficient time, the WG-Strategy did not provide input to the NetMundial open consultations.
