


**MULTISTAKEHOLDER ADVISORY GROUP APPOINTED TO PREPARE THE 20<sup>th</sup>  
INTERNET GOVERNANCE FORUM MEETING IN 2025**

The Secretary-General has appointed the members of the 2025 Multistakeholder Advisory Group of the Internet Governance Forum. A total of 40 members have been appointed, all being current or former members of the Multistakeholder Advisory Group since 2006 and/or Working Group on Internet Governance. The Advisory Group members are from all regions, representing governments, civil society, the private sector and the technical community. 

The main task of the 2025 Advisory Group is to provide advice on the preparations for the twentieth meeting of the Internet Governance Forum and to strategically guide the Forum's preparations for the 20-year review process of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS+20) and of the IGF mandate.

All Advisory Group members serve in their personal capacity but are expected to have extensive linkages with their respective expert groups and sectors. Representatives of previous host countries, former MAG Chairs, as well as representatives of the UN regional commissions and specialized agencies and other relevant international and regional intergovernmental organizations, are also invited to participate in the Group's work.

**About the Internet Governance Forum**

The Internet Governance Forum is an outcome of the Tunis phase of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) that took place in 2005. In the Tunis Agenda for the Information Society, governments asked the Secretary-General to convene a "new forum for policy dialogue" to discuss issues related to key elements of Internet governance. The mandate of the Forum was extended for another ten years in December 2015, during the high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the overall review of the implementation of the WSIS outcomes.
