

INTERNET GOVERNANCE FORUM 2024 NATIONAL, (SUB)REGIONAL AND YOUTH IGF INITIATIVES

SUMMARY REPORT

Action Items:

- NRIs coordinators to confirm final response on proposed endorsed moderators by 28 October. endorse the final list of speakers for the first segment of the NRIs main session by 30 September.

- IGF Secretariat to provide information on the proposed speakers' roles in other sessions; as well as to consult with NRIs collaborative session organizers to identify potential supporting roles for speakers not participating in the first segment.

- 1. The tenth virtual meeting of the NRIs in the IGF 2024 preparatory cycle took place on 22 October 2024 at 12:00 UTC. The meeting was hosted by the IGF Secretariat's NRIs Focal Point. The final adopted version of the Agenda is attached as Annex A1, the list of meeting participants as Annex A2, and the list of meeting inputs as Annex A3.
- 2. The meeting was convened to finalize the NRIs main session and coordination session, both hosted at the 19th annual IGF meeting in Riyadh, scheduled for 15-19 December 2024.

The discussion resulted in several action points summarised below.

Summary of points

- 3. After thorough discussions on all proposals for the onsite and online moderators of the NRIs main session, participants expressed strong support for Ms. Jennifer Chung (APrIGF) as the onsite moderator. The key criteria for this decision were her expertise and prior experience in moderating similar sessions. Furthermore, this selection was noted to enhance regional diversity, as no previous NRIs main sessions have featured an onsite moderator from the Asia-Pacific region.
- 4. Several participants underscored the significance of the NRIs main session as a capacitybuilding platform. They emphasized the importance of involving young individuals to gain experience in session preparation and moderation. There was broad support for Mr. Pedro Lana (Youth LACIGF) to serve as the online moderator, with further discussions planned to address the interaction between the onsite and online moderators.
- 5. To enhance capacity development, it was suggested to involve the online moderator actively in session preparations and explore ways to increase their visibility during the session. Some participants proposed onsite co-moderation as an alternative, but a consensus was reached to carefully plan the roles and dynamics of the online and onsite moderators.
- 6. Following the selection of moderators, the NRIs main session's panel composition for the first segment was reviewed, with a strong focus on achieving gender parity. Of the two proposed



compositions, the below **c**omposition was endorsed as it achieves gender balance (three female and three male speakers). The final composition is detailed below:

- 7. All NRIs are requested to review the proposed arrangements and provide feedback by Monday, 28 October. In the meantime, the Secretariat was requested to share information on the proposed speakers' roles in other sessions; as well as to consult with NRIs collaborative session organizers to identify potential supporting roles for speakers not participating in the first segment.
- 8. It was reitatered that in the second segment of the NRIs main session, interested individuals can register to speak.
- 9. Once moderators and speakers are endorsed by the Monday deadline, the Secretariat will collaborate with them to finalize the annotated agenda. Backup moderators and speakers will also be identified as a contingency.
- 10. Regarding the agenda for the NRIs coordination session, given the adoption of the Global Digital Compact (GDC), it was agreed to include the GDC as part of the session's agenda.

Next Steps

- 11. The IGF Secretariat will circulate the action points for final endorsement on the NRIs mailing list.
- 12. A doodle poll will be sent for scheduling the next NRIs call in November. The focus of this meeting will be to further plan of the NRIs coordination session.
