#### **OVERVIEW**

The IGF was held under the theme, "The Impact of Digital Transformation in St. Vincent and the Grenadines". The purpose of the IGF is to bring together multi-stakeholder groups and individuals to discuss and share best practices on Internet Governance issues. The Forum also promoted a common understanding of how to maximize Internet opportunities and address different types of challenges that arise, in a bottom-up, multi-stakeholder, open, and transparent manner.

#### **PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES**

The IGF organizing committee arranged flyers and other social media postings to promote both the IGF 2023 and the ICT Roadshow. Additionally, a radio program and a television program were done.

#### **GENERAL AUDIENCE**

The target audience was comprised of members of the SVG Chamber of Industry and Commerce, Government and regulators, IT Managers/IT Technicians/IT engineers, tertiary level students, the Elderly, and other Internet users in general. Face-to-face attendance on Day 1 (IGF) was 57. Online attendance was 36.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

This year, there was a spirit of collaboration and the IGF joined forces with ICANN and CaribNOG, who also found ways to widen their net to include representation from CTU.

IGF 2023 benefited from the presence of Rodrigo de la Parra (VP of LAC GSE), Albert Daniels, and Nicolas Antionello from the ICANN Management team, along with Dr. Claire Craig (Secretary, LACRALO) and Bevil Wooding (CaribNOG Cofounder and Director of Caribbean Affairs – ARIN). Their presence made the event special as it took on an international feel and sense of a return to normalcy compared to years prior during the pandemic era.

Finally, The IGF collaborated with Mr. Winston George Project Coordinator of the Caribbean Digital Transformation Project (CARDTP) to help realise of the Forum. The IGF was able to negotiate with the Project to make their team of experts available for the event. In addition, the project was able to assist the IGF in having facilitators from various departments in the public sector. Their input contributed immeasurably to the success of IGF 2023.

#### **KEY TAKEAWAYS AND LESSONS LEARNED**

- 1. Digital transformation will touch the lives of the whole society.
- 2. There are elements of fear largely due to a lack of knowledge and adequate information about the subject.
- 3. The greatest challenge seems to be among the elderly who are less exposed to devices and access to the internet and are more resistant to change.
- 4. The process of transformation will be gradual allowing for phased implementation and application of well-planned change management.
- 5. There is need for many more sessions like the IGF 2023 to spark the interest, debunk misguided impressions, manage fear, and project clarity to citizens who have concerns.

# LOOKING FORWARD TO IGF 2024

IFG 2024 will continue to echo the concerns of internet users as they emerge. It is expected that, with an exciting period of development ahead, topics concerning Artificial Intelligence, DNSSEC and Universal Acceptance, the continuing digital transformation and more, will demand more ventilation. Our workload will increase as we endeavor to fulfill our purpose. The topics and themes for 2024 will reflect the current times.
