

Dynamic Coalition on Gender and Internet Governance session

Description:

The internet is a critical global resource that enables women to exercise their right to speak, impart opinions, share ideas, build knowledge and access information. As the digital world became complex, internet governance has advanced to deal with this complexity. However, the discourse on gender and internet governance has remained somewhat static. It still remains limited to the three recurring themes raised 20 years ago-achieving gender parity in internet governance, enabling women's access to the internet -preventing online harassment and violence that women face. It is yet to evolve to meet the aspirations, realities, needs and expectations of not just women but all genders. Not just access but a measure of digital citizenship has to be ensured. The Dynamic Coalition on Gender and Internet Governance session aims to speak address and discuss this. The draft sexual harassment policy for IGF will also be discussed in this session so that inputs from others involved in the arena can be incorporated.
